

PARTY HOST JOB SPECIFICATION

CurveMotion is renowned for the quality of their parties. The Party Hosts of CurveMotion play a vital role in ensuring the smooth operational running of parties and maintaining the extremely high standards of both parties and the whole venue.

In addition to hosting parties the Party Host will also be required to take on the duties of a general host. Full training will be given on all aspects of the role including the different types of parties on offer to our customers.

The person taking on this role will have constant interaction with customers of all ages, and therefore exceptional communication skills are vital. The quality of the venue must be exceptional in all aspects especially customer service. The Party Hosts will report to the shift Duty Manager.

The duties of a Party Host will include (but not be limited to) the following:

- Ensuring the birthday child and party organizer has a special birthday experience throughout their visit
- Ensuring everything is ready for the party arrival e.g. table, guest list, presents etc.
- Meeting and greeting the party organizer, birthday child/person and all party guests
- Following all training given regarding the operational aspects of hosting the party e.g. serving food, liaising with staff, assisting the party organiser etc.

In addition the duties of a general CurveMotion Host are varied and will include (but not be limited to) the following:

- Ensuring customers enjoy their experience at CurveMotion in a fun and safe environment
- Managing the safe entry and exit of customers to and from the venue
- Working on the servery or coffee bar providing food and beverages

- Working tills and handling cash
- Monitoring the play frame and slides
- Ensure customers adhere to all Rules of Entry
- Cleaning duties as required

No previous experience is required however applicants must be enthusiastic, self-motivated, dedicated, well presented and professional at all times. They must display excellent inter-personal and communication skills. The ability to work as part of a team is essential.

The role will demand flexible and varying working hours including evenings, weekends and bank holidays. Appropriate training will be given. Pay will be dependent upon age and experience.
